When Covid 19 appeared and lockdown was announced, life as we knew it came to a halt. Certain things and support we get from people around us suddenly became questionable. Our maids, servants, security staff, car cleaners, housekeeping staff, drivers, gardeners, mechanics repairing most of the items inside our houses, AMC mechanics, car and scooter mechanics, the list seems endless, all became scarce and in most cases they just vanished one fine day. The lockdown had started.

The Government orders were clear, give monthly pay to your employees whether they come for work or not. In the initial stages all of us suddenly realised how dependant we were on people residing outside the society wall.

The shops, few operated by residents could open but who would supply the goods? All residents could consume what they had, shop online, but who would collect the garbage and waste? Plants would grow, leaves would fall, but who will do the needful to keep things neat and tidy.

In all this some things stand out. Our housekeeping staff comes from villages some of which are quite far away. They come by two wheelers. (You may have noticed the motorcycles parked on one side of the main entrance to the society.) The plumbers and electricians stay in Phi 3.

They came despite their own society shutting gates. The gardeners came for work after begging to be allowed to do so. The shopkeepers who reside outside, their employees and vendors also came and ensures that vegetables, milk etc were available to us.

All of us are indebted to these people, nameless to most of us, who came to serve even when the option was to stay at home as we were doing. The senior residents and others wanted to give some donations to these people who struggle to make ends meet every month.

To ensure that donations are equally distributed among all these people, it was suggested that donations be handed over to the society office. The Jalvayu Vihar society will give a receipt for the money received and at the opportune time distribute the money received to all these deserving people equally.

Please note that this is voluntary. If you so desire, then do so. There is no compulsion to donate. The office hours will be 1030 to 1300 hours every day but Wednesday.
