NOTICE ON GENERAL BEHAVIOUR **IN JALVAYU VIHAR SOCIETY**

We are under a forced lockdown to save us from the Covid 19 pandemic. One of the residents was found to be infected and he along with his family have been shifted to the quarantine outside the society premises. As understood now his son has also tested positive for Covid 19.

The Society management is a voluntary service for which none of the management staff is paid. The tenure of the present management has got extended as no elections are presently being permitted. **However, like in national politics, this does not stop some of residents from becoming politically reactive in anticipation of elections to be held in the future.** (No one can yet predict the exact time for this.)

Presently, with great effort, after interacting with officials at all levels it has been possible to ensure operation of the Society shops selling essential goods. It has taken a lot of effort to convince the housekeeping staff to continue operations. Thankfully the security staff has also been available to ensure entry and exit from the society is regulated as desired.

In this scenario of lockdown and total ban on gathering of more than four people, few of the residents have suddenly taken on themselves some roles for which they have neither been elected or nominated. Snatching the attendance register from the Main Guard room, scolding and threatening security staff, advising the housekeeping staff to abstain from work are some of the activities this group of people are indulging in.

The following points need to be noted:


1. The security staff has been working without a break all through this pandemic. They need to be supported and encouraged. Few of the residents continuously harass the security staff and pass allegations on their attendance and behaviour. If anything is amiss, it needs to be reported to the concerned management official, so that the matter can be investigated, and action taken.

2. Some residents have been telling the Housekeeping staff and the gardeners that they should not come for work as they will get paid regardless of attendance. The housekeeping staff has been paid incentives so that they continue to work and keep the society clean. Co-operation from all residents is requested and in the case of any complaint, the same can be made to the concerned person in the management.

3. Gathering in groups of more than four people is an offence under section 144 which has been implemented on the society. No movement within the society is permitted between 7 PM to 7 AM. All are advised to ensure they do not indulge in any activity which will entail extending of the lockdown and more severe restrictions within the society.

4. In this time of stress there are likely to be mistakes made. It is necessary to ensure that residents do not take matters into their own hand but inform the Society management so that corrective action can be taken. Please do remember that there is a team of Policemen and a Magistrate on duty on our main gate.

Finally, just bear with us for some more time and please co-operate. We do not want stricter restrictions within the society due to activism of some of the residents. Let us all work towards ending this lockdown and get back to normal life.
